## The Dassetts Sightseeing Tour

## ITINERARY

- 9am pickup
- Visit to Burton Dassett Country Park, open to visitors all year round with views that span miles. Tour includes a visit to the All Saints Church nestled in the Burton Dassett hills. Built in Norman times, by the Knights Templar, the church contains mysterious murals dating back to around 1350.
- Visit to Farnborough Hall, an 18th century country house surrounded by elegant lakes and fine landscape gardens. The Palladian style house is made from the locally quarried Horton stone.
- Lunch at The Inn at Farnborough.
- Visit another local National Trust property, Upton House and Gardens.
- Finish the day at the famous site of The Battle of Edgehill. The battle occurred in October 1642, during the First English Civil War. Round off the afternoon with a pint of famous, local ale in:
  - Edgehill's The Castle pub, boasting spectacular views of the battle site and the surrounding countryside. The pub's tower was built in 1742 to mark the centenary of the battle, and is said to mark the spot where King Charles raised the standard before the two sides clashed. The Tower first became a pub in 1822.
  - Ratley's Rose and Crown, a 12th-century pub where a Roundhead was discovered hiding in the chimney following the Battle of Edgehill and promptly beheaded. His ghost now reputedly haunts the building!
